Brian Brushfield did not seek re-election as President of the Geelong Past Players for season 2016. Brian was elected our leader at the Annual meeting in 2010 the first meeting he attended, setting a goal to serve two years and serving six. The first hurdle he encountered was to be told by Brian Cook that the Club rooms were to be demolished and all fittings in the rooms needed to be sold as they would not be required in the relocated area. The CEO told the committee the Past Players would not be disappointed in the new rooms and as of 2016 we have not.

Another challenge was to be introduced to Susan Kruss by Sharron Dickman and told Susan was prepared and capable to write a book on the 80 year history of the Past Players. I do not think at the time anyone thought it would turn out to be a 277 page document. With only rough minutes and the research of Susan, the memory of members the mission was completed and financed by the committee lead by Brian. To this stage no obvious mistakes have been directed to the committee.

Club member Tim was diagnosed with a serious condition and it was decided the best way to help him was to provide finance. This would enable him to concentrate on improving his health. A night for Tim was organized and a very successful night was held with just under 400 attending.

It was identified that in the 2000's the best way to communicate with members was the internet so a website was built. geelongpastplayers.com.

A Players end of season get together has been well received.

Recognizing a former player's contribution to the community, the committee put forward a nomination to the Australia day Council resulting in him receiving an OBE. Reunions, helping Alzheimer's with the Reminiscence Book, assistance to members, the Golf Day and a host of other projects have flourished under Brian Brushfield's leadership.

At the recent Australia Day celebrations former player Geoff Williams was recognised for service to Australian Rules football, and the community of Geelong.

Some of Geoff's contributions to the community include co-founding and running for 15 years Geelong's original YMCA little league football competition, working on the YMCA for a decade including two years as president, and starting and coaching an indoor soccer competition at Corio for five years from the late 1970s. The soccer competition took Geelong teams to national titles.


Geoff also helped establish Bell Post Hill's Cobradah drop-in centre and volunteered there for many years. He is a long- time member of Hamlyn and Western Heights Uniting and Geelong's Wesley Uniting Church congregations and Geelong West and Highton Combined Probus clubs.
